A Concise Big Picture Synopsis Of
Biblical Redemption

The thread of redemption runs through the entire Bible. However, when we limit the scope of redemption to the eternal salvation of man, we miss the bigger picture and distort the message.

- △ In the beginning God created a fully functional Heaven and earth.
- △ Lucifer was created by God to be the supreme governor over the Kingdom of God. He commanded the Heavenly Host and led them in worshipful obedience to God for eons of time until power and pride overtook him.
- △ Lucifer led one-third of the Heavenly Host in a hostile takeover the Kingdom of God, elevating himself to the position equal to God.
- △ Lucifer was cast out of Heaven and down to earth. Whether his physical or spiritual impact on earth caused the earth to “become” useless and void is a topic for another discussion. Some of Lucifer’s co-conspirators were cast to earth while others were chained in darkness.

- △ God created man, a most remarkable created being, modeled as a triune being after the godhead. Man was created to serve Him in a class above the angels but lower than the godhead. Man was appointed lord and governor over God's creation.
